NW – explains the 3 separate parts of a sports club membership


Social membership – as in past years but new protocol will be suggested without the sports pass “supporting membership”

DB has a moral issue with people having to pay to drink with their friends on a Wednesday night. Suggests a set guideline for all presidents to follow to make sure that these “supporting members” are getting something out of the club after giving their money.

DB asks for clarification on how much free reign presidents have over their funds.



SD asks for any clarity on what to do if a gender issue occurred, eg in a trans woman was to join netball can they play?

5. Updates from each position

NW –

Restrictions for the clubs who haven't submitted their budget or committee has not paid membership – restrictions are unclear as of yet, confusion of what can and can't be done

Game of the week going well good turn out – clubs nominating themselves or chosen by exec. Game of month going to “big clubs” at the moment, but will be selected on a month to month basis based on how the team are doing in their respective divisions. When game of the month is a Wednesday make game of the week on a weekend e.g Rugby/American Football. DB suggests using twitter to select a game of the week – create a buzz around the games and gets the clubs involved. SD suggests using Instagram as well, believes this is the most popular social media used by students.

EP –


Been to meetings
